


Lakeside EYFS and KSI Home Learning

wellies. If you don't have a copy of the book don't worry, you can find a CBeebies Bedtime Story version on YouTube - read by Pearl Mackie.


Attached are the suggested activities. Many of the activities can be adapted and done simply in a notebook, on paper or outside! Remember to go on the website for the accompanying resources.


Keep reading regularly!

Pretend you're Ellie. Write a thank you letter or note to Aunt Flo to thank her for your 'fantabulous wellies'!



Wellies come in pairs!


How many other things can you find in your house that come in pairs? Practise counting in 2s!
