




# Lakeside EYFS and KSI Home Learning






We hope that you are all staying safe and happy. It's been great seeing all the wonderful work you have been doing at home!

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








Read/watch and discuss the story:

Create your own shoe box aquarium








Create your own under the sea coral leef picture.

Stanley saw his own reflection in the pearl. Can you look in a mirror and draw
























Stanley was very brave in the story. Can you write a Brave Acrostic poem.
