If you don't have a copy of the book don't worry, you can find a version on YouTube - Once upon a story (see link)

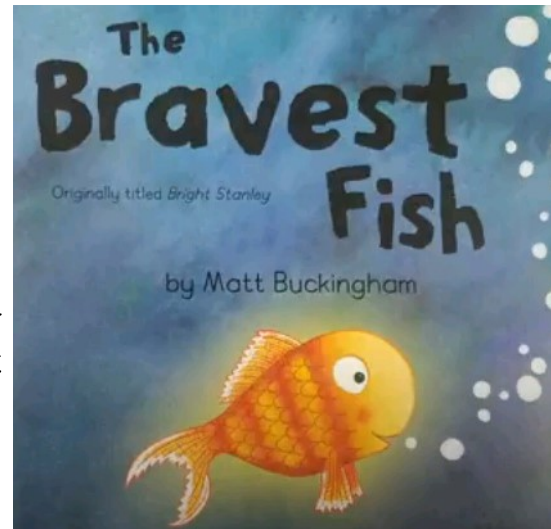
Attached are the suggested activities. Many of the activities can be adapted and done simply in a notebook, on paper or outside! Remember to go on the website for the accompanying resources.

Wider curriculum

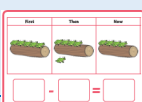
Take a photo of something that makes you happy? Don't forget to send it to your teacher.

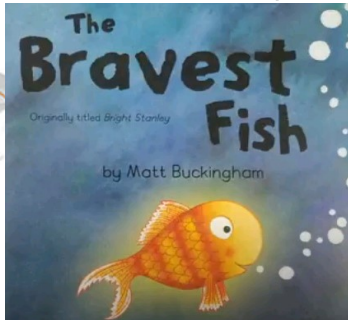

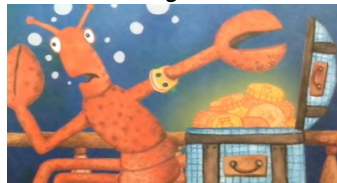

Create your own shoe box aquarium.

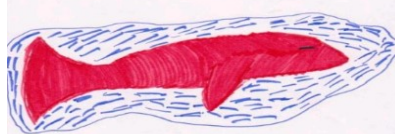


Create your own under the sea coral reef picture.
