
Lakeside EYFS and KSI Home Learning



Time Problems


A basketball game started at 5:00pm. It lasted for 1 hour, what time did it end?




A bus passes the school

every 30 minutes. The first bus passes at 7:30am, what time would the next bus pass?


Playtime begins at 10:30am. It ends at 11:00am, how long does it last?
