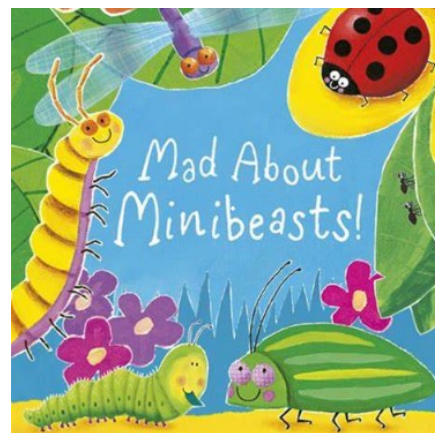


Lakeside EYFS and KSI Home Learning

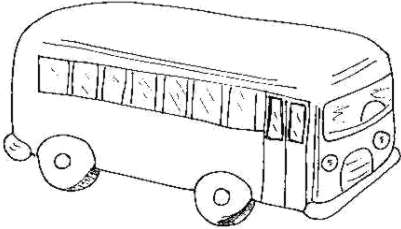

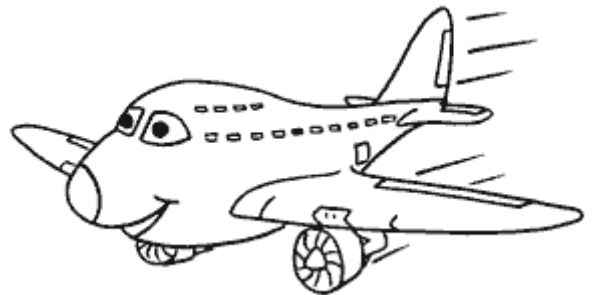
Time Problems

A basketball game started at 5:00pm. It lasted for 1 hour, what time did it end?

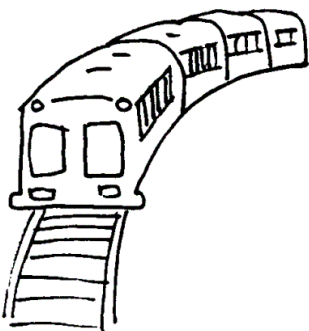


A bus passes the school every 30 minutes. The first bus passes at 7:30am, what time would the next bus pass?

Playtime begins at 10:30am. It ends at 11:00am, how long does it last?

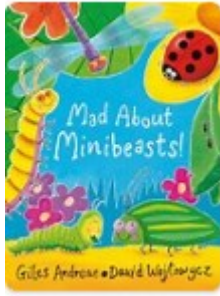


At 1:00pm a plane flies to New York from London. It takes the plane 5 hours to get there. What time would the plane land?

Pick your favourite minibeast and write some interesting facts about it.



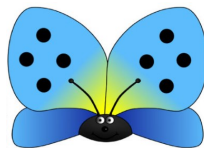
Write a riddle!

Can you write clues for your grown ups to guess the minibeast?

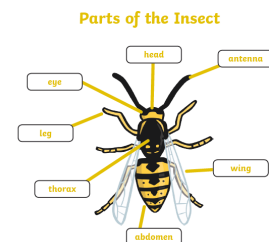


This butterfly has 4 spots on one wing and 4 spots on the other wing. How many spots does she have altogether? $4+4=8$

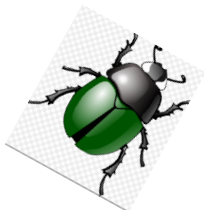


Can you make your own butterfly number doubles.

How many rhyming words can you think of that rhyme with the word bug?

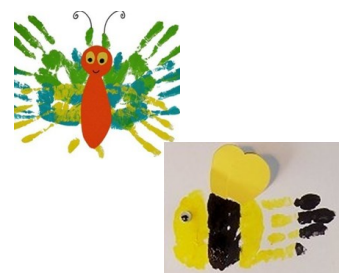


Write a list of all the words you find. Make a sentence with some of the words.

Make a minibeast hotel (there are lots of examples online!)

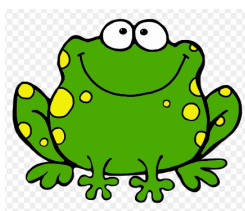


Make a minibeast using your handprint!

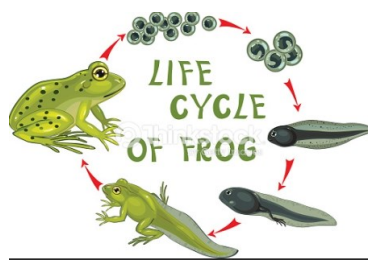


Find out about the lifecycle of a frog. Watch the programme Come outside on YouTube.

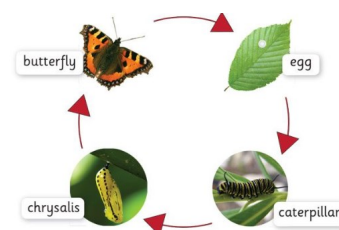


Draw, label and write about the lifecycle of a frog.

Make a counting caterpillar and play a game to put the segments in the right order.



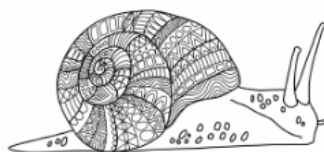
Paint a stone to look like a minibeast.
