The Road to War



1881
Germany, Austria-Hungary and Italy agree to protect each other from France.



Imperialism
Britain and France had growing empires, making them powerful and rich



1894
France and Russia formed alliances because they were afraid of Germany's power.



Russia and Germany were envious of their empires and wanted to form their own.



1898
Germany built up their first Navy and expanded the size of this. This caused fear in other countries



1914
Tension was high in Europe and they were ready for war.



1907
The Triple Entente was made, which was the alliance of France, Britain and Russia.
