Furthermore lunch will be provided for each child attending every day!** This is an absolutely amazing opportunity, and we are initially offering this exclusively to children who attend Schools in the surrounding area.

The Holiday club will run from 09:00 - 15:00 Tuesday to Friday, starting Tuesday 03^{rd} January to Friday 06^{th} January. It will be available to children aged 5 - 11. Children should bring plenty of water for the day.
