We can't believe we are in our last term in Reception! The children have learned so much and we still have many exciting things planned for their final term. We are looking forward to our Summer learning by immersing ourselves in our ASPIRE curriculum topics, *'The Farm' and 'In the Garden.'*

An overview of learning this half term

This half-term the children will be learning all about animals that live on a farm and creatures they might find in the garden.

We will continue having daily phonics, maths and literacy sessions and will enjoy having a daily 'squiggle whilst you wiggle' time to support physical development. During our 'achieving greatness' time, the children will be developing their independence in tasks such as independent writing, challenging themselves with maths problems, thinking creatively and developing friendships.

Research shows that reading for pleasure is the single biggest indicator of later academic success and is key in improving life chances

PLEASE remember to read with your child every day. Reading at home with young children is the biggest indicator that they will be successful throughout their school life.

Please also support your child to learn the phonemes that they get sent home – these are the ones that they are struggling with and need to know to help develop fluency in their reading.
