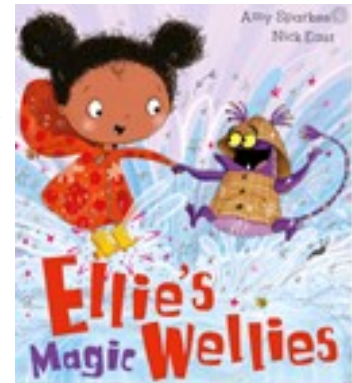


## Lakeside EYFS and KSI Home Learning

## Daily Essentials

### English

Use the 'Twinkl Live Lessons' Phonics videos on Youtube. There are a wide range of videos to choose from but we recommend using Phase 2 (blue) or Phase 3 (pink). After you've learnt that sound why not use your sound mat to practice writing it as well.

### Maths

Each day count 0-20 and then 20-0! You could use your number square to help you write these numbers too or you could find numbers around your house to help you with your number formation.

## Weekly Choices

### Memory Game

☐

Get your grown up to hide 10 items under a blanket. Can you remember which 10 items were hiding? Can you write what they are too?

### Number

☐

Choose a number, for example 6. Now write how many different ways you can make 6. Such as 3+3, 2+4... how many more can you find? Can you draw 6 dots? 6 cars? 6 flowers?

### Wider curriculum

☐

Draw a poster or picture of all of your friends who you are missing at school. You could even send this to your teacher to feature on the next newsletter!

### Rhyming Words

☐

Choose a CVC word—have a race with your grown up to see who can write the most rhyming words in a minute!

### Number

☐

Write a list of all the odd numbers and all the even numbers to 20. Can you see any patterns? Use Number blocks episode 'odds and evens' to help

### Wider curriculum

☐

Help your grown up with cooking or baking. What is your grown ups favourite thing to eat? What is your favourite thing to eat?

### Treasure Hunt

☐

Get your grown up to describe an object in your house. Can you find it?

Try describing the object based on their job/colour/size—"Can you find me something that helps me write?" etc.

### Money

☐

Investigate what coins you can find in your house. Maybe you could draw around them and write the amount. How much have you found altogether?

### Wider curriculum

☐

Find out which objects in your house float or sink. Make sure you check with your grown up which objects you can test in your experiment. Can you make a poster of your results?

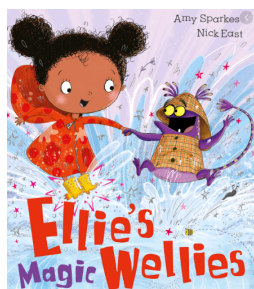

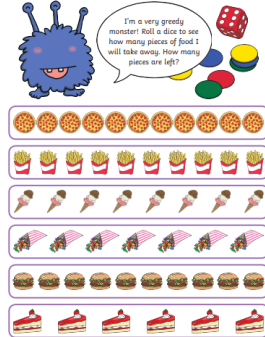
How many other things can you find in your house that come in pairs? Practise counting in 2s!



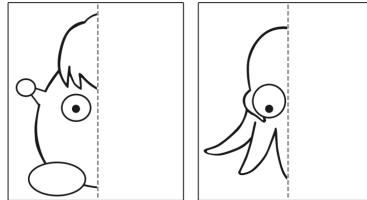


Play the greedy monster take away game! You will need a dice!

#### Greedy Monster Taking Away Activity Sheet

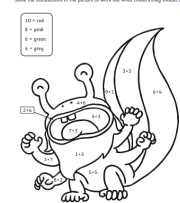


Have a go at completing the monster symmetry drawings. It's harder than you think! If you don't have a printer - ask your grown up to draw the first half!
