# Cardboard Tube Monsters



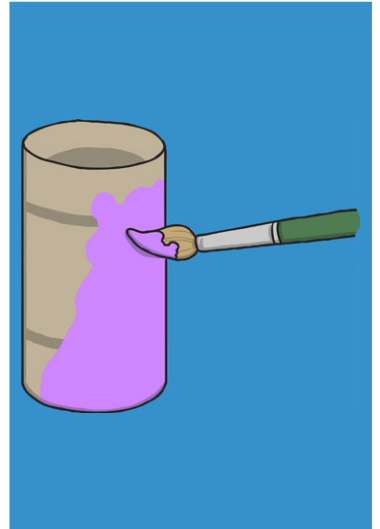
## Materials:

- Cardboard tubes
- Plastic bags
- Coloured paper
- PVA glue
- Recycled Materials
- Googly eyes
- Pipe cleaners
- Tin foil
- Stickers



## Step 1

Paint your cardboard tube. You might want to make it all one colour, or paint a pattern.



## Step 2

While your cardboard tube is drying, cut out some shapes for your monster's features, such as a mouth. You could use a plastic bag or coloured paper for this.



## Step 3

When the paint on the cardboard tube is dry, use PVA glue to stick your features where you want them. Add some googly eyes, or make your own.



## Step 4

Carefully make holes in your cardboard tube using a pencil. You can thread pipe cleaners through the holes to make your monster some hair or arms or legs.



## Step 5

Add other materials, such as tin foil or stickers, to design your very own perfect monster.
