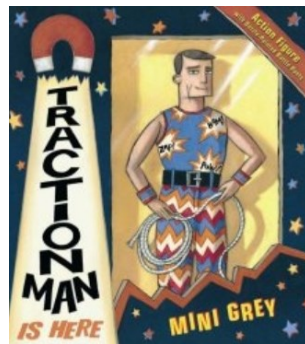


Lakeside EYFS and KSI Home Learning
