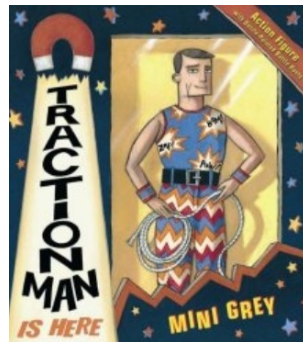


Lakeside EYFS and KSI Home Learning

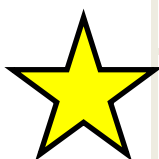

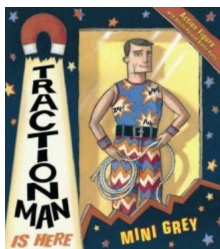

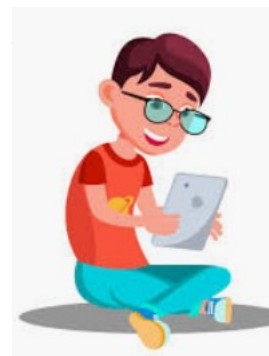

Make a set of instructions to teach people how to look after a pet scrubbing brush.

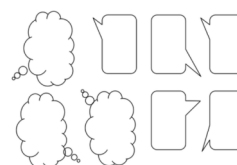

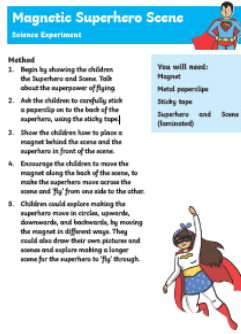
Design and build a box for a new Traction Man action figure or accessory.

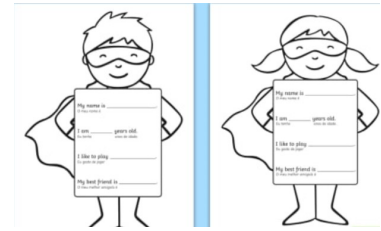

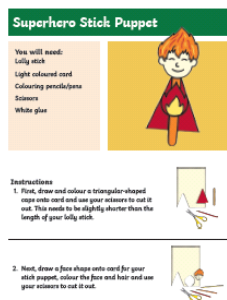

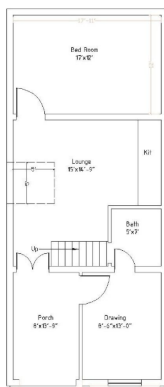
