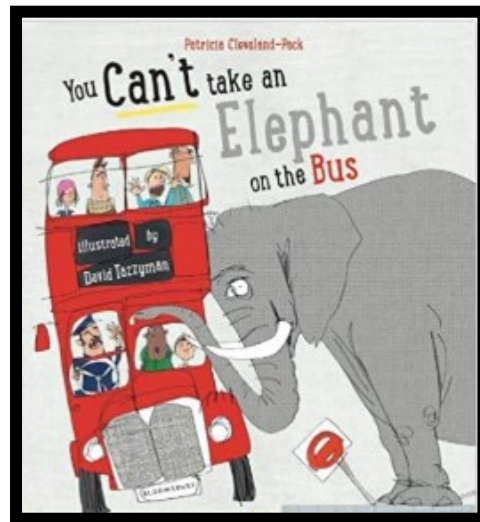


## Lakeside EYFS and KSI Home Learning

Can you make different amounts?

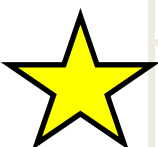

Design a boat using recycled materials that will float holding a toy animal you have or any other object you want!

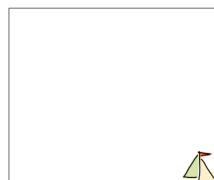


My boat design sheet

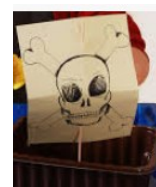

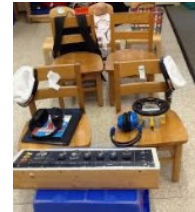

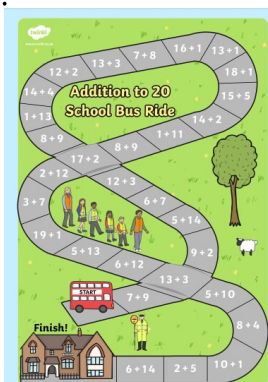

There are lots of different 3d shape in this book. Sing along with 3d shape song. And then go on a shape hunt in your house.

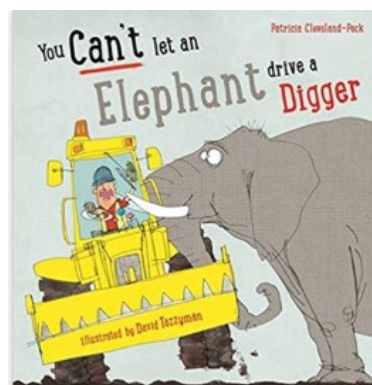
